Dear Sirs,

I return, under separate cover, two copies of the plan, forwarded with Mr. Wray's letter of the 14th instant, of Welin Maclachlan Gravity Davits intended for Messrs. Soc. Anon John Cockerill's Yard No. 675, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the davits be constructed as shewn and to your satisfaction, they will be approved for the maximum load and outreach indicated on the plan,

The steel to be used in the construction of these davits must be made by the Open Hearth process at works recognised by the Committee, and be tested by you in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

You should satisfy yourselves that the workmanship is sound and should pay special attention to the electric welding of <sup>the</sup> davits. The Rules for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction must be complied with, and the electrodes used comply with Section 4, paragraph 1-9 of these Rules.

The remaining copy of the plan is being retained for reference.
