It should be pointed out, however, that these are limited to the swan-neck ventilators, and no particulars ^{appear to be} ~~are~~ given of the proposed scantlings of the large swan and cowl ventilators to the holds and tween decks, and these might be embodied on a separate sketch and submitted for approval.
