

Messrs.Soc.Anon.John Cockerill's No. 675.

It is submitted the Antwerp Surveyors be informed with regard to their letters of the 9th instant and 31st ultimo with reference to the hatch webs and covers of the above vessel, that with the disposition of webs as now detailed by them the scantlings of these members as shewn on the plan No. 92552 approved on the 6th December 1937 are suitable for cargo of normal density stowed in the trunks.

It might be added for the Surveyors' information that the note regarding the density of the cargo in No. 3 trunk was made on the assumption that webs were not to be fitted at "C" or "D" decks, but their letter now states ^{that} they are only to be omitted at "D" deck, and on this account this note is not now applicable.
