Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Ministry of Shipping state that the ex-German Steamer "KURLAND", No. 79908 in Supplement to Register Book, has arrived in the Firth of Forth, where she is to be handed over to the British Government.

They add that it is the present intention of the Ministry to lay the vessel up pending sale, and request that a condition survey be held upon her sufficient for the general condition of the ship to be reported upon without going to the expense of opening up or drydocking, and I have to request that you will give the case the necessary attention.

I may say that the vessel has been allocated for Management to Messrs. James Cormack & Co., of your port.
