The Bergen Surveyor reports the vessel placed on a slipway, bottom coated and minor repairs effected.

The Surveyor recommends the examination of the chain cables and chain locker now done be taken as part of the 3rd Special Survey No.2, due 9,40. This appears to be in order.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 9,39.
