H. Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that information has been received that the steamer "CHIMAN", ex "Diana", has been sold to the ~~Compania~~ *Trasmediterranea*, and in the circumstances I shall be glad to learn whether this information is correct, and if so what arrangements the new Owners propose making for the outstanding survey requirements to receive attention.

I think it well to add that the vessel was understood to be under survey at Antwerp in April last year, for Special Survey, but no report on this matter has reached this office, and in the event of the vessel having changed hands as reported, I shall be glad if you will endeavour to ascertain the nature and extent of the survey carried out at that time.

I have also to say that there is some doubt as to whether the change of name of this vessel from "DIANA" to "CHIMAN" was carried into effect.
