Dear Sir,

A With reference to your letter of the 15th instant, with its enclosures from the North British Diesel Engine Works Ltd., in regard to the fees for the survey of the machinery of the Tug "DAINTY" an account for which was rendered to them by you on the 30th August, and paid on the 29th ultimo, I have to inform you that as the fees in the case of this type of vessel are payable by the Admiralty, the accounts are rendered direct from this office, the amount paid by the Engine makers in this case viz:- £32. 4. 0 should be refunded by you from your Petty Cash Fund. I shall be glad therefore if you will arrange for this to be done.

I have at the same time to add that an account has to-day been rendered to the Admiralty for the fees due for the survey of the hull and machinery of this vessel during construction, and the amount which will be credited to your port for the survey of the engines and boilers during construction at the makers works is as under:-

For survey of Engines.....£32. 4. 0.
(Glasgow Report No.38033)
For survey of Boilers..... 16. 2. 0.
(Glasgow Report Nos.38064-5)

I shall be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries in regard to the fee for the survey of the boilers is now entered in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.


