SURVEY FEES TWIN SCREW TUG "DAINTY" "STOIC" TYPE.

The ^{accounts for} fees for the survey of the hull and machinery of vessels of this type are rendered in accordance with the arrangement made with the Admiralty, direct from this office to the Admiralty. It appears that the Glasgow Surveyors have collected from the makers of the engines in this case the fee for the survey of the engines during construction at the works of the North British Diesel Engine Works Ltd., ~~which has been paid by them.~~ This firm now point out that as the fees are payable by the Admiralty they will be glad for the amount paid viz:- £32. 4. 0 to be refunded.

It may be added that the arrangement with regard to the payment of the fees for these tugs is as stated above viz:- that accounts should be rendered direct to the Admiralty, and in the circumstances, the Society's Surveyors at Glasgow it is submitted should be instructed to refund the amount paid by the Engine makers.
