M. With further reference to your First Entry Report No. 19304 on the Twin Screw Tug "DAINTY", I have to inform you that you still omit to state the particulars of the hawsers, warps, etc. supplied in this case, and I shall be glad if you will forward the same by return.

At the same time you should also state whether cement is fitted at the fore and after ends, as required by the Specification, and whether the notation of "Part Asphalt and part Cement" should be made in the Register Book; also whether the main frames of the vessel are of bulb angle, as required.
