This Norwegian vessel previously held
 the records LMC CS 6.35, DBS 11.38, Port S(CL) 10.38,
 1.38
 starboard S(CL) 5.39 and Lloyd's RMS 8.39.

The S.S. No.3 due 12.38 had been almost
 completed as a CS by 12.39, and the DBS was also held then.
 The vessel's class was subsequently omitted from the reprint
 of the Register Book. Two reports were later received from
 the Bergen Surveyors on advancement of the CS and grounding
 damage.

Reports from 2.43 onwards have now been
 forwarded by the Bergen Surveyors. These deal with the
 advancement of the CS. They also recommend a record of
 DBS 5.44 but the report on the ~~advancement~~
 commencement of this survey
 is missing.

In accordance with the Committee's decision
 of 9th August 1945 regarding vessels owned in countries
 formerly occupied by the Germans, it is submitted the
 vessel's class be reinstated in the Register Book with the
 previous records of LMC CS 6.35
