Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 26th ultimo regarding the motoships "ENGLAND", "ESBJERG", "JYLLAND" and "PARKESTON", we beg to inform you that the M.S. "ENGLAND" has been sunk at Kiel and is considered as lost.

The M.S. "ESBJERG" some time ago struck a mine near Stevns (Denmark) and sank; salvage facilities not being available at present the Owners do not consider it likely that the vessel will be saved.

The M.S. "JYLLAND" has disappeared, but in case the vessel should be recoverable, she will be submitted to reclassification.

The M.S. "PARKESTON" is at present undergoing Special Survey No. 3 at this port.
