S. Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 12th August last enclosing correspondence you have had in connection with the collection of fees charged in the cases of the steamers "FUH WO" and "LI WO".

It is noted that these vessels are on Admiralty requisition and that the Admiralty Officials are undertaking their maintenance, and in these circumstances, they come within the scope of the arrangements detailed in my letter of the 4th July 1940, a copy of which is enclosed.

You will see therefrom that in such cases you are only to undertake surveys at the express wish of the Naval Officer-in-Charge, and your accounts should therefore be withdrawn in the cases under review.

I may add that the necessary amendments have been made in the books here.
