We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 448 building by Messrs. Hongkong & Whampoa Dock Co Ltd for Messrs. Indo China Steam Navigation Co. Ltd Hongkong 600 Tons. Length 164-9 ft WL Breadth 30 ft, Depth 9 ft 6 in. intended to be Classed A Shallow Draft River Vessel.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
