the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of The Master and Agents (Vacuum Oil Coy. Pty. Ltd.) survey the single screw Tanker "MADRONO" - 5894 tons gross of Kristransand, for the purpose of endorsement of the vessel's Load Line Certificate to allow deeper loading agreed upon by the Norwegian Government.

The vessel was surveyed concurrently with Annual General Examination in dry dock and afloat and her condition is considered suitable for the deeper loading contemplated.

Alterations required by the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, as follows, have been satisfactorily carried out:-

The fore and aft gangway supports have been fitted with cross diagonal transverse and longitudinal bracing of 3" x 3" x .40" angles.

Side scuttles in superstructures have been fitted with cast iron hinged deadlights where these were found to be necessary.

A suitable provisional endorsement dated 10th June 1942 has been attached to the vessel's Load Line Certificate.


