
I return herewith two copies of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 20th instant, of midship section, profile and decks and shell expansion of two single screw tankers Nos. 69 and 70 proposed to be built by Messrs. Odense Staalskibsvaerft, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with and the material and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction the vessels will be eligible to be classed 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" with the notation "Longitudinal framing at bottom and deck".

The steel to be used in the construction of these vessels must be made by the Open Hearth process at Works recognised by the Committee, and must be tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

The remaining copies of the plans are being retained for reference.
