# Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners representative survey the S.S. "MICHAEL JEBSEN" 2323 tons gross of Hull (formerly classed with Germanischer Lloyd's) on 26th May, 1942 and subsequent dates and the following parts of hull and machinery were examined in dry dock and afloat

**HULL:-** Bottom, rudder, holds, tween decks, bunkers clear of coal. Fore peak, machinery space, structure under boilers, decks, casings, ventilators, hatchways, closing appliances, general equipment, windlass, steering gear.

**MACHINERY:-** Propeller, after end of stern tube, under water sea connections L.P. & I.P. valves and faces, electrical installation, Port and starboard boiler, port and starboard boiler safety valves adjusted under steam. Remainder of machinery examined as far as practicable.

and that we will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs recommended have been satisfactorily completed, and that we have recommended that she be assigned a notation of "Examined L.R. 6,42" indicating that from the parts now seen she appears to be in an efficient condition for a period of 12 months from 30th June, 1942.
