The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

In May last the Glasgow Local Secretary wrote that the Managing Owners for the Ministry of Shipping stated that this Danish steamer was lying at Hong Kong and was to be transferred to British registry, and it was desired that a General Examination be made for the purpose of a special record 'Examined L.R. (with date)' being made in the Register Book.

The Hong Kong Surveyors were advised accordingly.

Their report has now come to hand. The vessel has been Generally Examined in dry dock and repairs or renewals to steering chains, deck and shell plating, effected.

New anchor chain cable to replace cable worn below size was stated to be at Bombay, and it is anticipated this will be placed on board when the vessel arrives at that port.

In the Surveyors' opinion the vessel is in a satisfactory condition for 6 months.

It is submitted a notation of 'Examined L.R. 6.40' be now assigned - valid for 6 months.

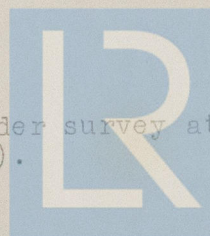
