

EX-GERMAN AND DANISH PRIZE SHIPS NOW BEING  
OPERATED BY THE DUTCH AUTHORITIES

With a view to meeting the wishes of the Dutch Authorities it has been agreed that the vessels mentioned below shall be retained in the Register Book under their German names, with ownership and flag left blank. No records of surveys or particulars of class assigned by this Society are to be posted, but details of these will require to be transmitted confidentially to the Netherlands Shipping & Trading Committee by letter on every occasion that a report is received from the Society's Surveyors.
