Dear Sirs,

Reverting to previous correspondence regarding the notation to be made in the Society's Register Book in respect of the Motor Tanker Yard No. 218 built by Messrs. Vulcan Werke of Hamburg to class with this Society, and also in the case of the similar vessel "GENERAL GASSOUIN" which is classed with the Bureau Veritas, it is noted that in the case of the latter vessel the Bureau Veritas have agreed to the notation in the next issue of the Bureau Veritas Register being made as follows:-

In Column 4:- "Oil in Bulk and specially arranged for bulk
"lubricating oil";

In Column 16:- "Long Frmg. 14 Comp. and 14 round tanks"; and further that the Owners desire that a corresponding notation may be made in the Society's Register Book.

In reply thereto I have to state that no objection is seen to this course and the notation at present recorded in the Society's Register Book will be amended accordingly.
