Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Brown's letter of the 15th instant, enclosing a copy of one received by Messrs. Palmers Shipbuilding & Iron Co. Ltd., from the Owners of the s.s. "STANASFALT", respecting the notation to be made in the Society's Register Book in regard to the rudder of this vessel, and the contents have been noted.

With regard thereto I am directed to state that, as intimated to the Builders by Mr. Brown, it has never been the Society's practice to make any record in the Register Book describing a patent design for a rudder, and that the proposal to do so in this case cannot be approved. The notation will therefore be as previously stated, viz:- "Rudder Electrically Welded", and I shall be glad if you will inform the Builders accordingly.
