The N.E. Marine Eng. Co's Contract No.2872.

I duly received your letter of the 15th instant, forwarding a plan of an additional cylindrical boiler proposed by The North Eastern Marine Engineering Co., Ltd. for the above contract, and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 180 lb. per square inch, provided the positions of the two lower longitudinal stays at the back end be amended as now indicated on the plan and the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the steel for the shell plates, butt straps, girder plates and manhole doors, viz:- 29-33 tons per square inch.

The plan is returned herewith, and I shall be glad if you will forward a verified copy for purposes of reference in this Office.
