The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/32.)

The class is subject to indented bottom plating, including D.6 and E.6 & 7, being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The 1st Special Survey No. 3 due 11.39 has been partly held.

The Genoa Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom coated, the Special Survey advanced and minor repairs carried out.

The indented plating as above continues efficient.

It is stated the Special Survey will be advanced on the vessel's return to Genoa in about 3 months' time.

It is submitted action be deferred.
