Dear Mr. Turnbull,

I notice that on the First Entry Report on the motorship "SUMATRA" (at present being "posted") the dimensions given are those measured according to English practice, and as the registered Italian dimensions are probably now available, would you very kindly arrange for these to be forwarded to me in order that they may be entered in the Register Book above the English Figures, as provided for in the Key to the Book.

In connexion with the same subject, could you see your way to indicate to the Genoa Surveyors that in the cases of registered Italian vessels, these two sets of figures are required? Hitherto it seems to have been the practice of the Surveyors at that port to furnish only one set of figures on their First Entry reports, whereas Trieste First Entries invariably give both, and I think you will agree with me that it would be as well to be consistent in the matter.
