
I beg to inform you that the steamer "FRED BORCHARD" of Hull No.60197 in the Register Book capsized on the 8th instant 20 nautical miles south west of Skomvaer outside Vestfjord, North Norway due to the deck cargo shifting and the wreck is evidently drifting off the Norwegian coast.

Salvage steamer is endeavouring to salve the vessel.

The vessel was on her voyage from Kem to London with a cargo of timber.
