Action has been deferred for equipment.

The Antwerp Surveyors now report the vessel afloat and 9 lengths of chain cable supplied to replace equipment lost.

The spare anchor has been fitted in the place of a lost anchor.

The Surveyors recommend a bower anchor be placed on board at an early opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject to a bower anchor being supplied at an early opportunity.
