I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the bronze propellers to be supplied by the Fonderies et Ateliers des Pompes et Moteurs for the M.S. "ZWEENA", and in reply I have to acquaint you that on completion of the examination and testing of these propellers a Certificate should be issued on the special form provided for the purpose, a supply of which is being forwarded to you, under separate cover.

With regard to the question of fees, I may point out for your guidance that in the United Kingdom a fee of £1-1-0 each (exclusive of travelling expenses) would be chargeable for the testing of propellers of this size, and the Certificate should be transmitted to the party responsible for the payment of the fees. A copy of the Certificate issued should be forwarded to this Office.
