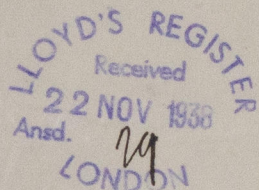

Reverting to my letter of the 20th Ult<sup>o</sup> relating to defects as were found at first test (temperature of the winding in excess of that permitted by the Rules) and your reply to same of the 25th Ult<sup>o</sup>, stating that the motor cannot therefore be accepted at it stands; I beg to inform you that the Makers have now carried out modifications on ventilation and shunt fields.

A new 4 hours test has been done with satisfactory results as mentionned in Rpt.7.(b) herewith attached.
