E. I duly received your letter of the 20th instant, with enclosure, relating to a $14\frac{1}{2}$ H.P. motor intended for the Motor Vessel "ZWEENA", the contents of which have been noted.

In reply I have to say that the temperature rise of the winding is in excess of that permitted by the Rules and the motor cannot therefore be accepted as it stands. It will be necessary to repeat the 4 hour test after modifications have been carried out, and a fresh test certificate will require to be submitted for consideration.
