E. With reference to your Rpt.7b in respect of Motor No.40333 manufactured by Messrs. Etablissements Jacquet Freres for the Motor Vessel "ZWEENA", I have to acquaint you it is not clear what temperatures have actually been recorded as the temperatures indicated on the Report as 26°C. for various parts of the machine coincide with the air temperature, yet a temperature rise of 58°C. has been recorded for the commutator, this latter rise being higher than that permitted by the Rules. I may add that the temperature rise should be the actual machine temperature minus the air temperature.

Further, no insulation resistance test has been recorded on the Report.

I shall be glad to receive your comments in regard to the foregoing.
