Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of this afternoon respecting the new Motor Vessel "POSEIDON", as follows, viz:-

"POSEIDON Middlesbro report 8454 hull fees paid Builders  
"very anxious for first entry and freeboard certificates"  
and in reply thereto I have to inform you that this vessel proceeded to Amsterdam for her machinery, and the report has not yet been received from the Society's Surveyors at that port.

With regard to the freeboard of this vessel I may add that particulars of the same were forwarded to the Rotterdam Surveyors on the 1st May last with a view to the issue of a certificate by the Dutch Government Commission, but no advice has yet been received stating that the same has been issued.

The Society's Surveyors at Amsterdam and Rotterdam are being communicated with in regard to the case.
