## Details of Casualty

This vessel was crushed by another ship which dragged anchor and grounded off Breezy Castle, Jamaica, during a hurricane on the 17th August. She sustained very considerable damage, and was later condemned as a constructive total loss.

No reply has been received to the casualty notice addressed to the Owner on the 4th October.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION

THE HURRICANE IN JAMAICA  
 Motor vessel MARAVAL ashore, not surveyed, but considered a constructive total loss.

Kingston, Ja., Aug. 28. According to the local Press, steamer JAMAICA PRODUCER dragged her anchor and grounded off Breezy Castle during the hurricane here in the night of Aug. 17, crushing in the vessel MARAVAL.

MARAVAL. — Kingston, Ja., Aug. 28. Motor vessel Maraval. Hull plating and frames have heavy damage on starboard side and plating pierced in several places. Port side in water, not seen. Bows crushed, boat deck crushed, both sides, vessel flooded and listing to port about 30 deg. Surveyor considers cost of salvage and repairs would exceed insured value.
