


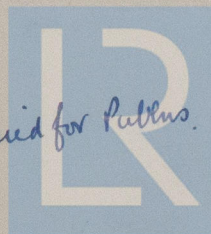
I shall be glad to receive a reply to the enquiry contained in my memorandum of the 27th April last, respecting the above-named vessel.
