Extract from Section 1 of the Society's Rules for Yachts. The following Fees are to be charged to Owners or Builders for surveying yachts prior to their Classification in the Yacht Register when Surveys are held in the United Kingdom :—

For the Special Survey during construction of Yachts (to entitle them to the distinctive mark ∇), for each Yacht, equipment numeral according to the Yacht Rules, is

under	700	£9
700 and under	1100	12
1100 "	1600	15
1600 "	2300	18
2300 "	3200	21
3200 "	4400	24

4400 and under	6000	£27
6000 "	8000	30
8000 "	10000	33
10000 "	12000	36
12000 and above,	a uniform charge of £3 per 1000				

For the Special Survey during construction of Engines and Boilers (to entitle them to the distinctive mark ∇ in red) shillings per nominal horse-power for the first 250 horse-power; three shillings for each horse-power from 251 to 500; one shilling for each horse-power from 501 to 1,000, and sixpence for each horse-power beyond 1,000. No Fee to be less than £9.

For the survey and testing of each auxiliary boiler, a fee of Four Guineas will be charged.

MEM.—In exceptional cases an additional charge will be made according to the service performed, and in all cases where the expenses are incurred by the Surveyors in connexion with the above services, they are to be defrayed by the parties incurring them.

In no case can the yacht be classed until all fees, travelling expenses, &c., due thereon are paid.
