Dear Sirs,

The Committee have had before them at their Meeting today the Surveyors' reports of their recent examination at Irvine of the steamer "JARGOON".

The vessel has been placed on a slipway and the requirements of the Special Survey, which became due in January last, carried out both on the hull and machinery.

The screwshaft was drawn for examination, and it is reported that the liner was found thin and slightly slack, but fit for further service.

It is recommended that the liner be renewed within 12 months, and in the circumstances the Committee have assigned a docking date of 5,51 Irv., S.S.Irv. 5,51 (Dr.), + LMC MS 5,51, subject to this being done.
