Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "CHELOHSIN," which is reported to be lying at Vancouver after having sustained heavy damage through stranding on the 6th November last, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had the case of this vessel under consideration, and as it is understood that she has been declared a Constructive Total Loss, I am directed to inform you that, in all the circumstances, it has been decided to make a record of "Stranded 11,49-Refloated" against the vessel's name in the Register Book, and at the same time to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon her reclassification by this Society.
