We duly received your Air Letter of the 15th instant regarding the case of the Steamer "CHELOHSIN" and have been in touch with the new Owners, Mr. Victor David, 1025 Main St., Vancouver, B.C.

This vessel is at present beached at North Vancouver. The Owner states arrangements are being made for her to be moved towards the end of the present week with a view to effecting necessary repairs to the shell plating. It is intended then to launch the vessel pending a decision as to her future service.

Mr. David is apparently hoping to find a buyer for the vessel and will probably then submit her for survey.


