In reply to yours of Jan 25, the S.S. Chelohsin is now in the course of preparation for dry-docking. Would you therefore please hold her in the same classification.

There is no truth in the rumour that I am planning to use the same as a floating paint plant.

The vessel still retains her engines, and is not a non-propelled hulk as rumour would have it. The damage done while grounding in Vancouver Harbour was very slight and no machinery or boilers were damaged. The intention is to ask for a survey at an early date.
