With reference to your First Entry Report on the new steamship "POELAU TELLO", I have to acquaint you that the Winterthur Report No.93 referred to was for Messrs. Sulzer Bros' Engines fitted in the m.s."ASAMA MARU".

The Winterthur Report No.94 also referred to under the heading of "Spare Gear" was for engines No.5732 fitted in the m.s."POELAU BRAS".

It would appear that the Sulzer Engine fitted in the "POELAU TELLO" is that numbered 5724; Winterthur Report No.92 which was forwarded to you on the 3rd January, 1929. I therefore cabled you today decoded as follows:-

"Return Winterthur Surveyor's report 92 Sulzer Engine 5724 report was forwarded you 3rd January 1929."
