"TABLE A FREEBOARD DOORS IN BULKHEADS IN UPPER TWEENDECKS
"SHOULD BE WATERTIGHT AND MAY BE OF APPROVED HINGED
"PATTERN TO YOUR SATISFACTION AND ARRANGED TO BE CLOSED
"FROM EITHER SIDE stop DOORS LOWER TWEENDECKS SHOULD BE
"OF APPROVED HORIZONTAL SLIDING PATTERN OPERATED FROM
"ABOVE WEATHER DECK."
