ANSWER.

With reference to the Starboard Screwshaft Survey and Boiler Survey, which became due in September and November last respectively, I have to acquaint you that on the 29th March, 1949 the Owners' London Agents intimated that the vessel was laid up, but that as soon as there was any prospect of her returning to service the above surveys would be attended to. It is noted from the Shipping Papers that the vessel is at your port and it is concluded that she is still laid up, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.


