The Ministry of Transport state that a formal investigation has been ordered into the circumstances attending the foundering of the above ship off Arbroath, Scotland, on the 9th November 1948, and that the case has been fixed for hearing in the Council Chamber, Municipal Buildings, Hartlepool, on the 25th July, commencing at 10.30 a.m.

It is desired that Mr. Craig should attend this investigation for the purpose of reporting on any matters raised which concern this Society. In case of any difficult point arising he should not hesitate to communicate with this Office by telephone.

A copy of a Memorandum which has been drawn up in connection with the Reports of surveys carried out by the Society's Surveyors on this vessel is enclosed for Mr. Craig's guidance.
