S.S. "MARTIN CARL" - Sld.Rpt. No.34719.

With reference to your letter of the 15th instant, we have to inform you that 6 x 6 x .38 vertical angles have been fitted connecting the margin plating to the tank side brackets abaft  $\frac{1}{4}$  length from stem in way of the upper deck.

The after peak bulkhead stiffeners were taken from stock and are 5 x 3 angles - with a minimum thickness of .30. We would point out that the size of stiffeners on our copy of the approved profile is 5 x 3 x .26" angle.



The intermediate bulkhead in forward hold was dispensed with at the Owners' request and the Builders asked for a letter in accordance with yours of the 15th August, 1946, but this has not yet been furnished.
