With reference to your First Entry Report No. 84392 and Report on Form 8 on the steamer "SAMUEL DRAKE", I shall be glad if you will state whether the survey now carried out can be accepted as a Special Survey No. 3, and if so, whether it was considered necessary to drill the shell plating, and if the plating in way of the sidelights (if any) has been examined.

You should also state the spacing of the forecastle beams, whether the rivets in the frames are spaced 7 inches or 7 diameters apart, the diameter of the hand pumps, and whether you are correct in reporting on page 4 of the First Entry Report "One deck (steel - wood sheathed)", in view of the particulars given on page 1 of the Report.
