They should also state the spacing of fore-castle beams, if the rivets in frames are spaced 7 inches or 7 diameters apart, the diameter of band pumps, & whether they are correct in reporting ^{on page 4 of report} a 1 duke (steel-wood sheathed) in view of particulars given on page one.
