We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 782 building by Messrs. Hawley & Wharfedale Dock Co Ltd for Messrs. La Naviera Filipina Inc. Cebu of 600 Tons. Length 140 ft Breadth 29 ft 9 in, Depth 12 ft 7 in. intended to be Classed 100 A1. for Coasting Services Philippine Islands.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the 'Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
