Dear Sir,

We duly received your letter of the 6th inst. in connexion with the Special Survey of the above vessel and in compliance with your request have filled in the drilling results on the form you forwarded for that purpose.

We shall appreciate it very much if you will kindly amend the recommendation on our Report 4966 to read S.S. Wln.6-49.

With regard to the drilling results, in the undersigned's opinion the error was occasioned by the fact that the old type of forms in this office are not suitable for typewritten results. The Surveyor had to handwrite them and the clerk failed to split them off correctly when posting. We enclose the original which should have accompanied our Report 4966 but was found filed with its copy.

We should appreciate a supply of the larger form per the sample you sent us.

We regret the error in the date recommended for the Special Survey. The vessel is normally laid up as a standby ferry boat and the Surveys are carried out when other work is not offering.
