and intended for installation in Messrs. Cochrane & Pons Ltd.,

These gears were built in accordance with plans approved by this Society for use in conjunction with 4SCSA Heavy Oil Engine, 8 cyls. 12 1/2" dia. x 15 stroke developing 650 BHP. 750 COM. B.H.P. at 400 R.P.M. and the materials and workmanship are good. On completion they were subjected to shop tests for ahead and astern running, reversing and idling with satisfactory results.

For the purpose of identification the shaft couplings were stamped.
