I duly received your letter of the 30th ultimo enclosing prints Nos. 6588/46 and 6589/46 showing the trawl winch wiring diagrams in the case of the above trawlers.

From examination of these prints it is noted that the exciter mains and a pair of conductors to the master controller are shown supplied from an "auxiliary switchboard". If this supply is intended to be taken from the ships' bus-bars, details of the switches and fuses controlling the circuits are required and the length of the cable runs.

In this connection I think it well to mention that no provision of this kind is shown on the Builders' plans of the electrical installation for Messrs. Cochrane & Sons' Yard No. 1319 already approved.

I shall be glad if you will kindly furnish two further copies of each of the above drawings, one for retention in this Office and the other for the use of the Society's Surveyors concerned.
