Messrs Harland & Wolff Ltd., of Belfast, examine the 1 double-ended and 2 single-ended boilers constructed by them and now intended for the Twin S.S. "GRAPHIC".

The scantlings of these boilers were found to be in accordance with the Rules for a working pressure of 215 lbs per square inch.

The material used in their construction was tested by the Society's Surveyors, and the workmanship, so far as could be seen, is good.

These boilers were tested at 373 lbs per sq. inch in the presence of the undersigned Surveyor, and found sound and tight.

Working pressure not to exceed two hundred and fifteen pounds per square inch.

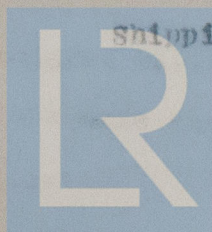
