Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 10th instant regarding the submitted plan of the oil fuel bunkers of the S.S. "GRAPHIC", I have to state that the pressure to which the bunkers may be submitted is to a height of oil to the top of the overflow pipe which is six feet above the crown of the bunker. 131

An electric alarm is fitted to the overflow tank to ring when this tank is three quarters full and only in case of neglect of or failure of this alarm and consequent filling of the overflow tank and pipes attached thereto would it be possible to get 12 feet pressure on the bunker top.
